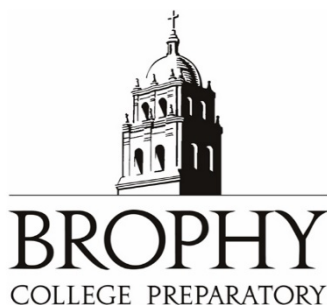

- 27 units (minimum) required for graduation:

- Students accrue 40 hours of service in 10th grade, 40 hours in 11th (60 for Honors IE)
- All classes taught at college preparatory level or higher. Students are admitted to Honors/AP courses based on academic performance, teacher recommendation, and department approval. **Dual Enrollment** courses from Rio Salado Community College are offered in some subject areas. We follow an 80-minute course **block schedule**.
- **Honors** courses receive additional .5 additional grade point.
- **Advanced Placement** courses receive 1 additional grade point.
- **Art & Innovation** requirement of 3 credits is elevated and may affect number of AP/Honors courses taken over four years.
